

American Defenders of Bataan and Corregidor Memorial Society Scholarship Application

The ADBC-MS is now accepting scholarship applications for the Fall 2019 school year. Recipients must be a descendant of a person who was a Prisoner of War of the Japanese during WWII. A maximum of three scholarships in the amount of \$1000 each will be awarded. Applicants must currently be high school seniors or in the first, second or third year of college. In addition to the application, three additional documents are required: a letter describing the applicants' course of study and educational goals, a letter of acceptance to an accredited university, college or trade school, and an essay about the POW relative including information about his/her experiences during the war and his/her captivity. The essay should be historically accurate and demonstrate an understanding of the political and military environment surrounding the conduct of WWII in the Pacific.

Applications and all materials must be received by May 31, 2019. Applicants will be notified of decisions after June 30, 2019. Scholarships will be paid upon receipt of **proof of matriculation** in an accredited post secondary technical school or college.
